

We are in the middle of our Membership Battle! See details below in our membership promotion segment and help the chapter by promoting membership in your company.



Grassroots Government Activities Committee (GGAC)

Happy holidays to everyone! Looking forward to seeing everyone at the holiday party this month. I'd like to take a minute to let you know that we're actively planning an event for GGAC called a "Day on the Hill".

We're planning this with several regional chapters and I would greatly appreciate any participation. Details are still being ironed out, but this is a quick overview of the "Day on the Hill" entails:

GGAC Encourages Chapters to Hold Day on the Hill Events

ASHRAE's Grassroots Government Advocacy Committee continues to encourage Chapters to coordinate a Day on the Hill (DOTH) visit with your state or provincial legislative body. In years

past, Chapters in seven states and in Canada organized meetings with their elected leaders, provided information about ASHRAE and offer to be the "go-to" professionals when issues arise affecting the industry. It is the goal of the Committee to continue promoting the DOTH visits and a number of Chapters have already been contacted. The Committee also encourages those Chapters who held a DOTH visit in the past to do so again. Additionally, a second major focus this year is the establishment of a program, by each Chapter, to make regular contacts with members of the U.S. House and U.S. Senate for their State. Meetings with the member and local staff of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives could be held at the local offices throughout the State. The GGAC has established an MBO to develop this program, therefore, you will be receiving more information in the near future.

BEQ

The BEQ of ASHRAE's has multiple new features. The impact of the BEQ portal in the HVAC-R and energy industries are increasing after the energy concerns started to become more effective in decision making. NYC has thousands of 100 years old building which require renovation eventually not only for climate concerns but also sustainability concerns of these properties.

Below is a quota from ASHRAE BEQ portal.

*For an official Building EQ Performance Score to be reviewed and approved by ASHRAE, the project must be submitted by a credentialed user. Credential Users include ASHRAE BEAPs,

ASHRAE BEMPs, DOE Better Buildings Workforce Guidelines Building Energy Auditors (AEE CEA), DOE Better Building Workforce Guidelines Energy Managers (AEE CEM and EMA EMP), and Professional/Chartered Engineers in the jurisdiction where the building is located. Credential users will also have access to several reports. There is a one-time set-up fee to verify credentials.

- \$0 ASHRAE Certified BEAP or BEMP
- \$15 ASHRAE member CEA, CEM, EMP or Professional / Chartered Engineer
- \$25 Non-ASHRAE member CEA, CEM, EMP or Professional / Chartered Engineer


