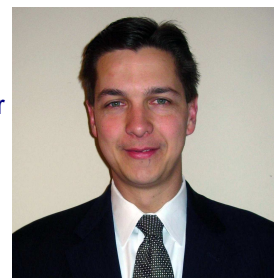

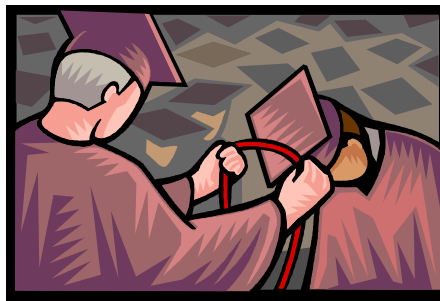

## Board of Governors - Meeting Minutes

The following items were discussed:

- **Treasurer** – Steve Giammona reported a checking account balance of \$ 15, 670.00 and a savings balance of \$ 7,100.00. All business card ads have been paid to date with only four outstanding. The invoices to SMACNA and ACCA for the joint meeting have also been paid. Payment to the Westbury Manor is current and we will issue check payments at the end of each meeting. Peter G. stated that the golf outing receipts total \$ 43,295.00 with \$ 5,050.00 still outstanding. Cherry Valley invoice was received in the amount of \$ 31,677.00. Steve G. to pay.
- **Resource Promotion** – Steve Giammona reported we have approximately \$ 8,000.00 in donations raised to date with approximately \$ 3,000.00 in commitments. Steve may need help in contacting and collecting final donations.
- **Programs** – John N. reported the June meeting will as planned be an informal evening, with an end of year celebration. ## CTTC

### **Walking the Talk: ASHRAE Moves Toward Sustainable Headquarters**

ASHRAE continues to move toward a sustainable headquarters with creation of a Webpage dedicated to the project and selection of an architectural firm.

ASHRAE currently is studying whether to renovate its headquarters in Atlanta as a sustainable building. The Society recently selected Richard + Wittschiede, an Atlanta architectural firm, to develop a schematic design for the project. ASHRAE also has created a Webpage so members and others can follow the progress of the project.

"This is an exciting opportunity to demonstrate the benefits of using ASHRAE's standards and to 'walk the talk' by creating a showcase for sustainable renovation," William Harrison, who is chairing the renovation committee, said. "We envision creating a 'living lab' where ASHRAE technical committees can conduct research projects to determine the effectiveness of procedures designed to conserve energy, to prolong the efficient operation of mechanical systems, and to improve indoor air quality."

"ASHRAE is addressing the larger global issues facing our world today by exploring renovation of its building and submitting for gold level LEED certification," Janice N. Wittschiede, partner, Richard + Wittschiede, said. "Richard + Wittschiede Architects is honored to have the opportunity to work with ASHRAE in developing a project that will provide an example of how a building can incorporate concepts of aesthetics and functionality as well as sustainability."

The Webpage, [www.ashrae.org/building](http://www.ashrae.org/building), contains photos of the building throughout the years, technical information about the building and a comments area.

"We look forward to considering ideas and suggestions from ASHRAE members and encourage them to explore the headquarters renovation page," Harrison said. "We want both our renovated headquarters building and the process we use to develop our plans to serve as models for the successful renovation of existing buildings."

Harrison also noted that the proposed renovation addresses the four goals outlined in ASHRAE's recently adopted strategic plan: by demonstrating sustainable construction, providing space and a laboratory for educational programs, demonstrating ASHRAE's expertise, and providing a global headquarters with technology features to serve the needs of members anywhere in the world.

### **ASHRAE, ASHE Partner to Ensure Healthy Health Care Facilities**

As part of a continuing partnership, the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) and the American Society for Healthcare Engineering (ASHE) will work together to advance and promote the mutual interests of engineers and health care facility professionals.

A memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the two groups was signed at ASHRAE's 2006 Winter Meeting held in Chicago.

"With ASHRAE having the primary expertise in HVAC and ASHE having the primary expertise in health care engineering, our joint efforts will ensure that the design and operation of our health care facilities meet the patients' needs for health and safety," Lee Burgett, P.E., ASHRAE president, said.

"Our signatures on this MOU signify an important day in the history of our two organizations," said William Morgan, SASHE, CHFM, 2006 ASHE president. "By formalizing the already strong relationship shared by ASHE and ASHRAE we have committed our organization to continuously improve engineering design and construction for the creation of optimal health care environments."

ASHRAE and ASHE are working together in a number of areas, including jointly developing proposed standard 170P, Ventilation for Healthcare Facilities. The proposed standard will define requirements for ventilation system design intended to provide environmental control for comfort, as well as infection and odor control.

ASHE is an association of diverse professionals dedicated to continued improvement in the health care environment through advocacy, education, information and collaboration.

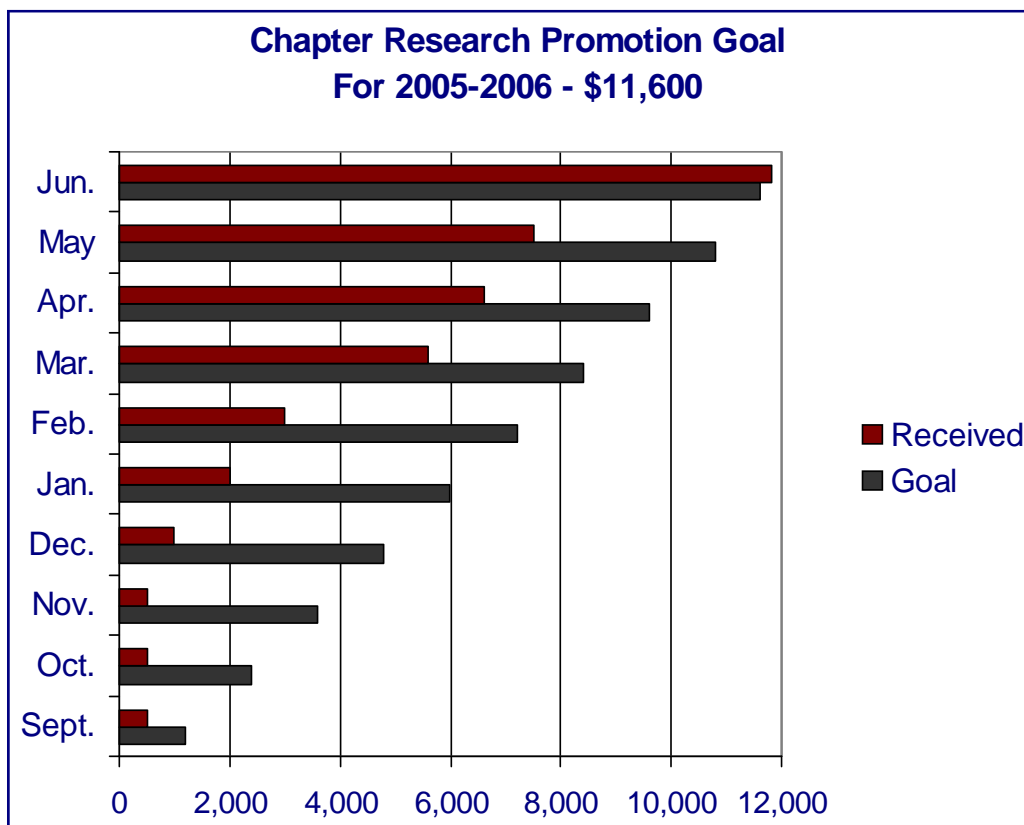
## Research Promotion

I would like to thank the Board of Governors and all of our active members for their support this year. I look forward to many more years of Ashrae and to continue supporting our local chapter.

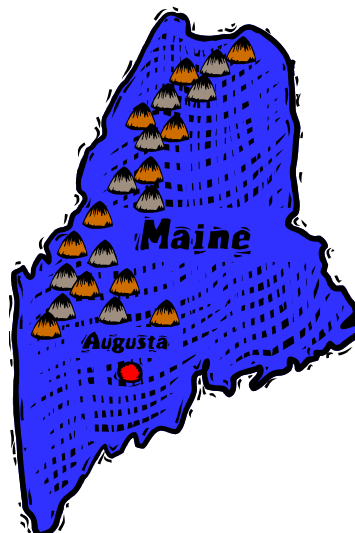
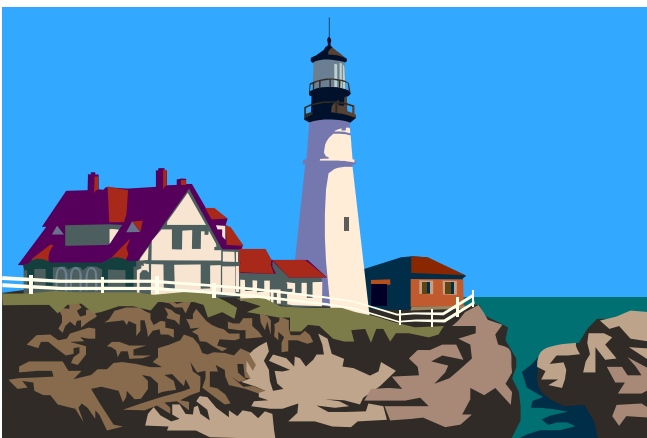

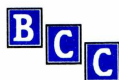
