NY S. 7176 and A. 8143 Updates:

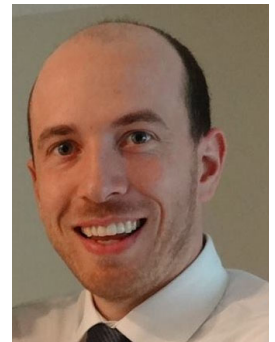
“Advanced Building Codes, Appliance and Equipment Efficiency Standards act of 2022” has passed both the Assembly and Senate. This bill clears a direct path for NY State to elevate the base State Energy Code to the highest in the nation and would take effect immediately once signed into law (or after 180 days of the State registrar receiving the updated ASHRAE Standard). This is a big moment for NY as the State will step squarely into the lead nationwide on energy efficiency and decarbonization. The bill is being reconciled and will then go to the Governor for signature.
